- **1. Content:** The Research paper must include- Rationale of the of Study, Objectives, Research Questions/ Hypotheses, Research Methodology, Major Findings, Implications and Reference. Tables, illustrations, charts, figures, formulae etc. should be placed within the text at appropriate places.
- 2. Referencing: APA style of referencing is to be followed
- **3. Format:** Length not exceeding 3000 words including cover page and references with margins of 1 inch from all the sides in Font: Times New Roman, 11 points, Justified Line Spacing of 1.5. The first page of the paper must contain the abstract. The entire manuscript must contain page numbers except for the abstract page.
- **4. Cover page:** The cover page should contain Title of the paper, Authors (s), Affiliation (s), and Contact Details. The name of the author should nowhere be mentioned in the paper other than the cover page.
- **5. Abstract:** Within 300 words (with maximum 5 keywords). Papers without soft copy will not be entertained.
- **6. Declaration:** The Author must send a declaration that the paper is original and free from plagiarism and has not been sent/ submitted for publication or presented anywhere in a format to be provided by the University after acceptance of the abstract. Authors must refer to the UGC guidelines 2018 for maintenance of standards and plagiarism of their papers.
- **7. Review:** All the papers will be blind reviewed by an expert committee with respect to their quality, originality, and relevance. All papers shall be verified for similarity in URKUND for acceptance of their papers.
- **8. Submission mode:** Full research paper in MS-word (electronic version) will have to be sent to: nseminar19.sem@gmail.com
- **9.** Selected reviewed papers will be published in conference proceeding bearing **ISBN** number.
